## Estimated Recovery Position

We have agreed with the Office of Gas and Electricity Markets (Ofgem) to publish estimates for the electricity distribution price control recovery position. These estimates are for the regulatory year April 2008 to March 2009 and are current projections for the position at the year end (31<sup>st</sup> March 2009), based on the tariffs effective from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2008.
