

# UK Power Networks



## STATEMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES

Covering Eastern Power Networks plc, London Power Networks plc, South Eastern Power Networks plc and UK Power Networks (IDNO) Ltd Licensed Areas

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## 1. INTRODUCTION

This statement has been produced to inform Suppliers, Generators, Licensed Distribution Network Operators and any other persons of our transactional based charges for the following companies: Eastern Power Networks plc, London Power Networks plc, South Eastern Power Networks plc and UK Power Networks (IDNO) Ltd, collectively referred to herein as “UK Power Networks”. These charges are for activities that support the Competitive Supply and Distribution Markets and will be billed by UK Power Networks on an individual basis for any service requested.

## 2. ENERGISATION, DE-ENERGISATION AND RE-ENERGISATION SERVICES

The following charges apply where the relevant service is required of the distributor rather than the Meter Operator. These charges are based on the energisation, de-energisation and re-energisation being undertaken at the service cut-out/meter position. Other methods of de-energisation, re-energisation (e.g. service cable joint), or any work associated with a connection at Extra High Voltage will be individually quoted.

### VISIT TO ENERGISE OR DE-ENERGISE SUPPLY

Each visit made to a premise to carry out an energisation, de-energisation, re-energisation or associated with connections to a Protective Multiple Earthing (PME) terminal, will be charged as follows;

E1	Single Phase or Polyphase (Direct) Installation – Standard Lead Time <i>(Equal to or more than seven full working day’s notice (Monday to Friday, excluding Bank Holidays))</i>	£247.39
E2	Single Phase or Polyphase (Direct) Installation – Short Notice <i>(Equal to or less than six full working day’s notice (Monday to Friday, excluding Bank Holidays))</i>	£325.80
E3	Cancelled Visit, less than 24 hours prior to scheduled visit time (E1 or E2)	£15.47
E4	Low Voltage Polyphase (CT) Installation or High Voltage Installation	£351.20
E5	Cancelled Visit, less than 24 hours prior to scheduled visit time (E4)	£40.87
E6	Abortive Visit <i>(where job cannot be completed due to circumstances beyond UK Power Networks’ control)</i>	£115.96

**Please Note:** The charges shown above for services E1, E2 and E4 apply during Normal Working Hours *(Monday to Friday (Excluding Bank Holidays) 09.00 to 17.00 inclusive)* only. Services booked to be performed outside of these hours will incur a surcharge of 50% of the specified transactional charge.

### 3. REVENUE PROTECTION SERVICES

#### Revenue Protection Site Visit and Investigation

A charge will be payable by the Supplier irrespective of whether the site visit and investigation was conducted at the instigation of the Supplier, UK Power Networks or another person (*as described in paragraph 3.1.1 of the Revenue Protection Code of Practice*). The work required to attend, investigate and correct the installation including obtaining warrants, in addition to the provision of relevant information back to the Supplier and attendance at court (if required) is included in the charges shown below. UK Power Networks no longer provides meters through its Revenue Protection Service. By agreement with individual Suppliers the Revenue Protection Service can provide meters, either directly or via a facilitated agreement with the Supplier's preferred MAP. Alternatively Suppliers can provide their own meters (or those of a MAP to whom they are contracted) to our Revenue Protection Service for installation.

R1.1	Successful Domestic Investigation (excluding work associated with R1.3) *	£299.87

R1.3	Successful Investigation Relating to the Cultivation and/or Manufacture of Illegal Substances (e.g. Cannabis factory)	£1004.62

\* 'Domestic' and 'Non-Domestic' are defined by the Profile Class assigned to an MPAN by the Supplier and registered in MPRS. Profile Classes 1 and 2 are classed as 'Domestic', and Profile Classes 3 to 8 and Half Hourly are classed as 'Non-Domestic'.

#### Emergency 'Making Safe'

The service provided will be to solely remove the fuse and make the installation safe. It will only be undertaken at the request of a Supplier that uses an alternative Revenue Protection Service provider.

#### Other Optional Services

Where the Supplier requests UK Power Networks' Revenue Protection Service to conduct a site visit which is not directly related to the incidents described in paragraph 3.1.1 of the Revenue Protection Code of Practice (Version 1), an individually quoted charge will be levied on the Supplier for any work undertaken.

#### 4. RADIO TELESWITCH SERVICES

UK Power Networks may provide Radio Teleswitch Services to those who wish to sponsor Group Codes. The charges for these services will be fixed by agreement in each case and will reflect the level of complexity in the proposed arrangements.

#### 5. DATA TRANSFER SERVICES

UK Power Networks is fulfilling its obligation to provide data transfer services through Electralink. Charges and terms and conditions for Data Transfer services will be according to the Data Transfer Agreement. Details of charges and a handbook describing the agreement are available from Electralink, Ground Floor, Grafton House, 2 – 3 Golden Square, London, W1F 9HR.

#### 6. CHARGES FOR METERING POINT ADMINISTRATION SERVICES (STANDARD LICENCE CONDITION 18 STATEMENT)

This section sets out the basis upon which charges will be made for the provision of metering point administration services.

## 7. DISCONNECTION OF SITE

Application to disconnect a supply:

Suppliers wishing to request a disconnection must submit a Disconnection Notice in accordance with their Use of System Agreement.

Where a party requests the disconnection of a site, then an individually assessed charge will be quoted.

Charges will be levied in accordance with UK Power Networks' Connection Charging Methodology.

In the case of HV or EHV connections we should be consulted at an early stage and a programme for the removal of equipment will be subject to individual assessment.

## 8. ACCOUNTING & ADMINISTRATION SERVICES

UK Power Networks reserves the right to impose payment default remedies. The remedies are as set out in DCUSA where applicable or else as detailed in the following paragraph.

If any invoices that are not subject to a valid dispute remain unpaid on the due date, late payment interest (calculated at base rate plus 8%) and administration charges will be imposed.

Our administration charges will be set at a level which is in line with the Late Payment of Commercial Debts Regulations 2002;
