Estimated Recovery Position

We have agreed with the Office of Gas and Electricity Markets (Ofgem) to publish estimates for the electricity distribution price control recovery position. These estimates are for the regulatory year April 2010 to March 2011 and are current projections for the position at the year end (31st March 2011), based on the tariffs effective from 1st October 2010.
